Pre-Game

I have written about Silver Knights woes before, but here we go again. They are at the bottom of the Pacific Division. They have the worst goal differential of -42. The combined +/- for forwards and defense are in the negative numbers. The results are contradiction to their competitive play, and the NHL affiliate the Golden Knights success. With 15 games to go and 10 points out of a playoff spot, the Silver Knights will look to be a spoiler for the rest of the season.

Head-to-Head: The Firebirds played last night and lost in overtime to the Condors. The Silver Knights last game was 6 days ago so they are coming in rested. Amazingly, the Silver Knights lead the season series 3-1-0-0. All games except the game the Firebirds won have been one goal games. Both teams will play in Coachella Valley tonight and Wednesday before finishing the final 2 season series games at Henderson in April.

1st Period

A tight checking first period. Both teams found some O-Zone time. After the 9-minute mark, the Firebirds had a nice cycle going. Tucker Robertson pass found its way to Ville Ottavainen who sniped a goal from

the top of the circle. Less than a minute later, Kai Uchacz of the Silver Knights powered in on a Firebirds' defenseman, and flipped a puck at the night that handcuffed Kokko and snuck in for a goal. The Silver Knights got the benefit of two power plays in the period, but the Firebirds prevented zone entry or got the puck out of the zone quickly to kill the power plays.

2nd Period

Another tight checking period. The Silver Knights got the lone goal in the period. Tanner Laczynski made a cross-ice pass to Alexander Holtz who shot that puck past Kokko who couldn't get over in time. Firebirds had couple power play opportunities. They move the puck around the zone, but couldn't get the puck on net.

3rd Period

Firebirds pressed, but they couldn't get the tying goal. The Firebirds got into penalty trouble late, which didn't help. Silver Knights didn't break when the Firebirds pulled the goaltender.

Post-Game

Tonight was the St. Patrick's Game, but there was no luck for the Firebirds. They played hard with a limited line up, but couldn't get over the finish line. The Silver Knights win another one-point game, and they are playing the spoiler role as expected. The Silver Knights play the Reign tomorrow, and both teams will meet on Wednesday.
