The scored their 2nd goal when the Firebirds over committed in the neutral zone, and Cameron Hebig picked up the puck to create a 2 on 1 with Andrew Agonzzino who went to the net. Firebirds had a couple 2 on 1 and a push in the last minute, but came up empty.
